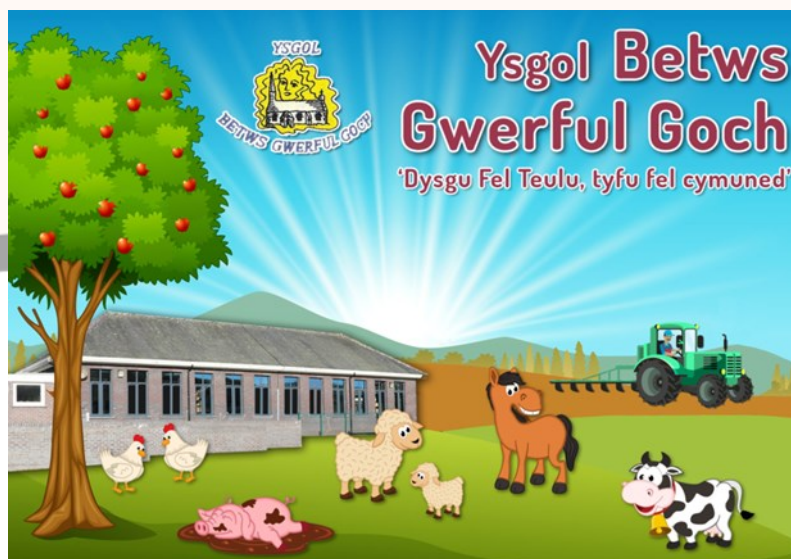

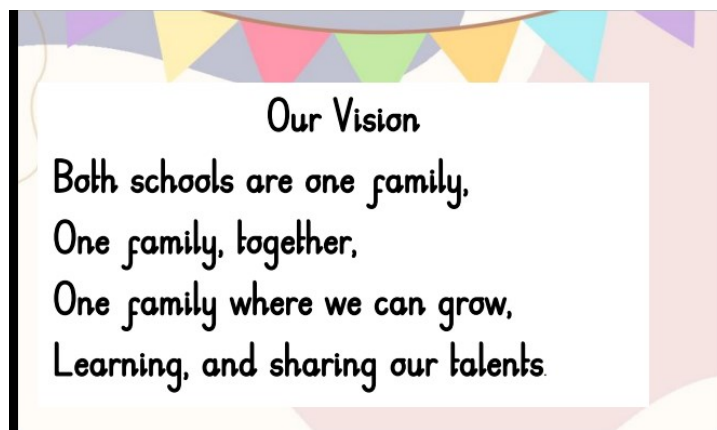

Blaenoriaeth 1- Datblygu sgiliau ysgrifennu estlynedig yn y Gymraeg ar Saesneg

Sut? Cynnig profiadau i'r disgyblion sydd yn sbarduno, ac yn ennyn eu diddordeb mewn ysgrifennu. Bwriadwn wahodd awduron a beirdd i'r ysgolion er mwyn cyd-weithio hefo'r plant. Bwriadwn ddatblygu llawysgrifen, geirfa, a defnydd ein disgyblion o idiomau, ansoddeiriau a chymariaethau.

Blaenoriaeth 3: Datblygu gwytnwch, a meddylfryd disgyblion drwy firenio ac addasu systemau cefnogi lles yn yr Ysgol.

Mae lles yn hynod o bwysig i ni yn y ddwy ysgol, ac ryden ni eisiau sicrhau bod ein disgyblion yn datblygu Sylfaen cadarn er mwyn eu galluogi i fod yn ddysgwyr gydol oes, eu bod yn hyderus wrth ddysgu, yn gwynebu heriau hefo meddylfryd positif, ac yn dathlu, ac ymfalchio yn eu llwyddiannau.

Blaenoriaeth 2-Datblygu cyfleoedd i

Rydym yn bwriadu ehangu ar gyfleoedd y plant i ddysgu yn yr awyr agored drwy fuddsoddi mewn offer, a chynnig profiadau megis Ysgol y goedwig.

Is- flaenoriaeth:

Parhau i ddatblygu sgiliau darllen a llythrennedd Saesneg dysgwyr hynaf y ddwy Ysgol (blwyddyn 3-6).

Mae gennym gynllun sillafu newydd, ac ryden ni wedi buddsoddi mewn rhaglen i ddatblygu sgiliau sillafu a darllen Saesneg y plant.



Priority 1- Develop extended writing skills in Welsh and English

How? We intend to develop the children's interest in writing, by inviting authors and poets to the schools to work together with the children. We will be focusing on developing the children's handwriting, vocabulary, and use of idioms, adjectives and comparisons.

Priority 2-Developing opportunities to learn outdoors

We intend to offer more opportunities for the children to learn outdoors by investing in equipment, and offering experiences such as Forest School.

Priority 3: Developing resilience, and pupils' mindsets by evaluating and adapting well-being support systems in the school.

Well-being is extremely important to us at both Schools, and we want to ensure that our pupils have a good Foundation to enable them to be lifelong learners, confident when learning, face challenges with a positive mindset, and celebrate, and take pride in their successes.

Priority: Continue to develop English reading and literacy skills of the learners of both Schools (year 3-6).

We have a new spelling scheme, and we have invested in a program to develop the children's English spelling and reading skills.

Priority 1- Enrich the opportunities for our learners to make choices, and develop independence in their learning, including recording methods. Ensure that feedback is constructive, and helps the pupils with the next steps in their learning.

Priority 5- Further develop distributed leadership within the school.

Rydym yn cyd-weithio gydag asiantaethau Anghenion Dysgu Ychwanegol allanol i sicrhau cymorth priodol. Mae'r Côd Anghenion Dysgu Ychwanegol yn weithredol yn yr ysgol.

Mr Robert Kimberley is responsible for our Additional Learning Needs provision at school which involves regular discussions with teachers, support staff and parents. Individual Educational Plans are given to children with Additional Learning Needs and teachers and support staff work hard to implement these plans as the children strive to succeed with his/her targets. We work with relevant outside agencies to ensure appropriate support. We fully comply to the Additional Learning Needs Code.

YR IAITH GYMRAEG/ THE WELSH LANGUAGE

Cymraeg yw iaith swyddogol yr ysgol, a'r prif iaith ar gyfer addysgu a dysgu. Nôd yr ysgol ydy sicrhau fod y plant yn ddwyieithog pan y byddant yn trosglwyddo i'r Uwchradd yn ll oed. Caiff plant y Dosbarth Sylfaen eu haddysgu yn gyfan gwbl trwy'r iaith Gymraeg. Cyflwynir Saesneg i'r plant ym Mwyddyn 3.

Mae Cymreictiad a thraddodiadau Cymreig yn cael sylw blaenllaw yn yr ysgol, llwyddodd yr ysgol i ennill gwobr Ôl-aur y Siarter Iaith eleni.

Welsh is the official language at Ysgol Bro Elwern, and is the main medium of learning and teaching. The school aims to ensure that our pupils are bilingual when they transfer to the Secondary school at the age of 11. Foundation Stage children are educated entirely through Welsh. Children begin English lessons in Year 3.

The school places a great emphasis on learning Welsh traditions, and the school successfully reached the gold Welsh Charter award again this year.
